WHEREAS, Bettie Satterfield,

on or about the 16th day of May in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Allen Satterfield, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 24th day of May 1930, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman,

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$2150.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said \_\_\_\_\_

J. A. Lunsford, the following described real estate;

"All that certain tract of land about four miles south of Greenville Court House in Gantt township, Greenville County, South Carolina and on the Stanton Bridge Road, and Beginning on said road at a red oak 3xnm, thence S. 79° E. 11.00 to a stone 3x; thence N. 24 E 20.45 to a stone 3xnm; thence N. 68 W. 23.14 to a stone 3xnm; the said being in Stanton bridge Road; thence with said road S. 18° W. 4.40; thence S. 27° W. 8.00 thence S. 15° W. 12.00 to the beginning corner, and adjoining other tracts of John A. Satterfield Estate, James Scott, Walter Rosemond, and others, and being tract No. 2 of the John A. Satterfield land conveyed to John B. Satterfield, by Charles A. Satterfield, W. Oscar Satterfield, and Anna N. Garrison by deed dated July 21, 1908."

It is understood and agreed that the grantee is to pay the State and County taxes for the year 1930, on the property herein conveyed.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said J. A. Lunsford, his heirs and assigns forever.
