and other valuable considerations and other things said to and before the writing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)

has granted, sold and conveyed unto J. Buchanan, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Ebaugh Avenue at corner of lot no. 116, as shown on plat of lot made by H. A. Odgers July 1917, and recorded in P. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4, page 32, which lot no. 116 is, or was the property of T. H. Bingham, and running thence with his line in a north westerly direction 140 feet to line of lot recently sold to H. H. Kempner, thence with his line parallel with Ebaugh Avenue in a northwesterly direction 35 feet to a stake in corner of line of lot no. 117, thence in a southwesterly direction and a line parallel with the first line above expressed 140 feet to a stake on Ebaugh Avenue, thence with Ebaugh Avenue S. 55° E. 75 feet to the beginning corner, embracing all the northern portion of lot no. 117, and the eastern half of the southern portion of lot no. 117, and all the same tract as been sold to grantor by J. C. Sutton, recorded in P. M. C. Office, Vol 113, page 37.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinafter named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
