Hunt; all that certain piece, parcels or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the first Ward, City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, known and designated as lot no. 2, according to plan made by R. C. Dalton, Engineer, September 14, 1927, and having the following lines and bounds to-wit; beginning at an iron pin on the North side of West Park Avenue, corner of lot no. 1, and running thence with said Avenue S. 76-40-21, H. 2.6 feet (to an iron pin); thence S. 26-0-6 E. 148 feet to a stake; thence S. 70-25-8 E. H. 3.3 feet to a stake on a ten foot alley in rear of lot no. 1; thence with said alley S. 65-23-15 feet (to a stake); thence S. 20-23 W. 158.8 feet to the beginning corner. As a part consideration herein the Grantor further conveys all his interest and right in a strip used by ingress and egress, a certain ten foot alley situate in the rear of lot no. 1, and adjoining the lot hereinabove described and having the following lines and bounds to-wit; beginning at a stake, corner of lot no. 2 and running thence with said lot no. 2 S. 20-23 W. 10 feet to a stake; thence with line of lot no. 1 S. 70-27 W.
