Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS,

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Genas L. Grier

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Genas L. Grier,  
Well that certain lot or parcel of land situated lying and being at Paris Station, in the County and State aforesaid, and having, according to a plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, which is recorded in R. M. Co. Office in Plat Book F. page 231, the following meter and bounds, to wit:-  
Beginning at an iron pipe in right of way of Southern Railway Company's main line tracks, 4 feet 6 inches North of North Bound Track, and running thence along a road, S. 7-43 N. 306.7 feet to an 1/2 in concrete; thence S. 58 N. 525 feet to an iron pipe on edge of paved drive; thence N. 31-47 N. 236 feet to an iron pipe 4 feet 6 inches north of North Bound Track of the main line of the Southern Railway Company; thence N. 58-03 E. 719.9 feet to an iron pipe the point of beginning.  
Together with all the rights and privileges which were granted to D. B. Taylor and W. B. Bradley by deed of Winter Homes Company, dated October 1st, 1920, and this deed is subject to all the reservations and restrictions and limitations set out in said deed.  
The above described property is the same conveyed by Bradley Real Estate Company to Allen J. Graham, by deed dated May 26, 1924, and recorded in R. M. Co. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 80, page 61, and thereafter conveyed by Allen J. Graham into the Trustees above named, by deed dated April 9, 1927, and recorded in the R. M. Co. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book - Page J. E. Sirrine one of the Trustees named in said deed of April 9th, 1927, having renounced and declined to act.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said

Genas L. Grier, his heirs and assigns, forever.  
The said Trustees do hereby bind themselves as Trustees, their successors and assigns, to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Genas L. Grier, his heirs and assigns, against them and their successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, through or under them.

AND Allen J. Graham himself and his heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Genas L. Grier, his heirs and assigns, against himself his heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
