H. Harris Irvine and Citizens and Southern National Bank,
as Trustees, an undivided one-fourth (1/4) interest of the whole
of, in and to all the following parcels of land to-wit,
all that parcel and lot of land in Greenville Township near
the Shodside Mill, County of Greenville and State of South
Carolina, containing approximately 1 1/4 acres, more or less.
This being the same conveyed to H. J. Irvine by Joe Cunningham
et al. See deeds Vol 58 page 322, and Vol 57, page 20.
