Road, just ridge from the Carter's Shop to
Paris Station, about three miles northeast of
Greenville County Courthouse, containing
one and five tenths (1.5) acres more or
less, more or less, having the following metes and
bounds to-wit:

of the concrete bridge on the road leading
from Mc Carter's Shop to Paris Station and
running thence with the center of said road
S. 69-45 W. 540 feet to a stake in center of

out of lines of the Stoddell Estate N. 134-957
