J. F. Hunt, his heirs and assigns.

All my undivided one-half interest in  
and pertaining to, all that certain piece, parcel  
or tract of land situate, lying and being  
in the State of South Carolina and County  
of Greenville about four and one-fourth miles  
from Greenville Court House and having the  
following metes and bounds, according to a  
plat thereof made by J. A. Adams, bearing date  
December 30, 1918, to wit:

Beginning at a stake at the junction of  
the old and new Easley Bridge Roads, and  
running thence along the old Easley Bridge  
Road N. 60 1/2° S. 12.76 chains to a stake in  
said road; thence along said road N. 59 1/2°  
S. 3.29 chains to a stake in said road; thence  
N. 75 3/4° S. 5.25 chains to a stone in said road;  
thence N. 20 7/8° S. 20.35 chains to a stone; thence  
N. 76 7/8° E. 19.70 chains to a stony; thence S. 75 E.  
3.55 chains to a stone; thence S. 52 1/2° E. 17.50 chains  
to an iron pin near the well; thence S. 20 E.  
7.10 chains to iron pin in road; thence following
