assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State  
aforeward, near the City of Greenville, and being known  
and designated as lot no 4 as shown on plat of the  
property of John Grizzera and having the following  
metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on McBeth Street, corner  
of lot no 3, and running thence along McBeth Street  
51' 46"-11 ft. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot no 5, thence  
along line of lot no 5 S. 54-20 E. 180.5 feet to an iron  
pin on Edwards Street, thence along Edwards Street  
N. 73-50 feet more or less to an iron pin, corner of
