Willimon line to iron pin; thence N. 55-36 E. 8.21 chs. to iron pin; thence N. 52-20 E. 41.75 chs. along C. P. Willimon line to iron pin; thence N. 37-30 W. 24.35 chs. along R. C. Willimon line to iron pin; thence S. 36-30 W. 5.34 chs. to iron pin; thence S. 42-30 W. 31.60 chs. to the beginning corner.
