all that certain lot, piece, parcel or tract of
land, situate, lying and being in the State of
South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in
Chest Special Township, being a portion of the
subdivision of C. M. Harton out near Pine
Station in the above County and State. Having
the following metes and bounds to wit:
beginning at a stake in the National High-
way corner lots 23 and 24 and running thence
along said Highway N. 81-45 E. 50 feet to a
stake, corner lots 23 and 26, thence N. 81-15 E. in
line of lots 23 and 26, 178 feet and 6 inches to
a stake, corner on the line of Piedmont and
Northern Railway right-of-way, thence N. 61-07 E.
53 feet and two inches along said right of way
to a stake, corner lots 23 and 24, thence S. 81-15
E. in line lots 23 and 24, 159 feet and 8 inches
to a stake at the beginning corner. This deed is

feet and 6 inches to a stake corner lot 25, thence
from said corner 178 feet and 6 inches to a stake
