the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. W. McColl and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

All that certain lot or parcel of land on West side of Hammond Street, in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, Beginning at stake on West side of Hammond Street, 90 feet from South Main Street, and running thence S. 41-06 W. 100 feet to iron pipe, 90 feet from North side of South Main Street, thence N. 36-47 W. 26 feet, thence N. 41-06 E. 100 feet to iron pipe on Hammond Street, thence with Hammond Street S. 36-47 E. 20 feet to beginning corner, being part of Lot No. 39 of the Prov. M. Waller Sub division made July, 1919, and being the same lot of land conveyed to W. A. Wallace by Thomas M. Walker Co., by deed dated Jan. 10, 1920, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Book 69, at Page 60.
