the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto

North Realty Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

All that tract of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about 7 miles from the City of Greenville on head waters of Rock Creek, waters Enorez River, known as Tract No 4 of the S. L. Vaughn farm, as shown by plat of same recorded in Plat Book E, Page 110, and having the following metes and bounds according to the said plat:

Beginning at a stake in branch of J. F.
