

This agreement made and entered into this the 28th day of October, 1925 by and between St. St. Burgis Charities Inc. a corporation under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and Shriners Hospitals for crippled children, a Corporation under the laws of the State of Georgia. Witnesseth whereas, the said St. St. Burgis Charities Inc. desires to have erected and maintained a hospital for crippled children at Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, and, whereas, Shriners Hospitals for crippled children is engaged in the work of erecting and/or maintaining hospitals for crippled children, but is at the present time not in condition to erect such a hospital in or near the State of South Carolina and said St. St. Burgis Charities Inc. has signified its willingness and desire to furnish the money to purchase a site of suitable size and location, said site and its location to be approved upon and approved by Shriners Hospitals for crippled children, and to furnish the money to erect, equip and furnish a hospital ready for operation upon said site; and said Shriners Hospitals for crippled children is willing upon completion and delivery of said hospital, and upon receiving the deed to the land, to take same over and perpetually maintain it and pay all expenses incident thereto; and whereas, the Board of Trustees of said Shriners Hospitals for crippled children, at a meeting held on September 30th, 1925, at Richmond, Va. did unanimously accept the proposition of said St. St. Burgis Charities, Inc. and did authorize and instruct its proper officers to enter into a contract in keeping with said proposition; now, therefore, it is hereby agreed between the parties hereto that said St. St. Burgis Charities, Inc. will furnish a suitable site and have same deeded to Shriners Hospitals for crippled children; the deed to provide that if the Shriners Hospitals for crippled children should ever cease to operate said hospital for said purpose, the title shall revert to St. St. Burgis Charities, Inc. and St. St. Burgis Charities Inc. will furnish the money to erect a hospital building of fifty bed capacity, and furnish and equip the same under the direction of Shriners Hospital for crippled children, and in accordance with plans and specifications drawn under its direction; provided that it shall not be bound to furnish for all said purposes a sum in excess of three hundred fifty thousand (\$350,000.00) dollars.
