Know all men by these presents, that we, J. T. Odens, Lora A. Cook, A. P. Odens, Charles Odens, Eliza Odens and Joseph Odens, in the State of said, in consideration of the sum of thirty seven hundred and one hundred dollars, to us (in hand paid at an before the sealing of these presents by J. T. Foster, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said J. T. Foster, all that piece, parcel and lot of land, lying and being in the city of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, located on the northwest corner of North and Clover Streets, said city, beginning at the aforesaid southwest corner of said north and clover Streets, and running thence with clover Street one hundred and sixty-two (162) feet to a point on the property formerly belonging to Lizzie Land Smith; thence in a westerly direction fifty-two feet, nine inches (52 ft. 9 in.) to a point on joint line of the old Smith property and adjoining lot; thence along said joint line one thousand and sixty-two feet to North Street; thence with North Street fifty-two feet nine inches (52 ft 9 in.) to the beginning corner, being a part of the property deeded to Lizzie Land Smith by her husband, Am. J. Smith, and being the same piece of property conveyed by the said Lizzie Land Smith to Leila Odens, for life, remainder to grantees, by her deed dated July 16th, 1908, and recorded in R. M. B. Office for said County and State in Deed Book Vol. 4, page 492. A plat of this land is recorded in Plat Book C. page 243, R. M. B. office for Greenville County.

The above referred to deed entails this property to the grantees until the youngest child of said Eliza Odens attained the age of twenty-one years, and as a part of the consideration for this deed, it is hereby represented by the grantees that Joseph Odens, the youngest child, was twenty-one years of age on January 26th, 1927, and that the grantees are the children of the said Eliza Odens, who died more than fifteen
