Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments appurtenances or in anywise appertaining to the above described Land I bind myself my heirs Executors admors and assigns to warrant and defend to above described Land unto Elizabeth A. Moore her heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors admors and assigns and against Person or Persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Given under my hand and Seal this October the 2 day A.D. 1871.
