

not apply to such part wherein the top of the pipe is less than eighteen (18) inches underground.

It is further agreed as a part of the consideration hereof that the grantor herein his heirs and assigns may make taps or connections with said pipe line at his expense, provided, however, that such connections or taps be made only under the supervision and rules of the engineer representing Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission or their successors.

It is further understood and agreed that in case of future damage to crops or property due from any accident in said pipe line that Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission shall pay reasonable damage therefor.

The payment and privileges above specified are hereby accepted in full settlement of all claims and damages for said easement.
