stake; thence along the east side of a 30 foot road passing
thru an iron pipe at 17.7 ft. S 81° 10' E. 315 ft. to a stake
at point of curve of said road; thence around a 22 deg.
45" curve 235 ft. to a stake - the course and distance of
chord being S. 35° 0' E. 228.2 ft.; thence along property of
Parrish, Conyers and Dower N. 61° 18' E. 0.48.5 ft. to an iron
pipe on right of way of S. & W. R. Railroad; thence along
said right of way 100 ft. distance from center of tract, a
traverse line being N. 46° 23' W. 7.2 ft. to a stake; thence
N. 51° 26' E. 42.6 ft. to a stake; thence N. 0° 50' W. 124.7 ft.
to the point of beginning same containing 5.00 acres, more
or less, according to survey made by R. C. Dalton, Engr.
Feb. 1923, and being the same tract of land conveyed to
me by W. P. Conyers by deed February 28, 1923 recorded in
C. O. Office, Greenville County in Vol. 89, Page 194.

Also, all that other piece, parcel, lot or tract of land
lying, situated and being in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, South Carolina, about three (3) miles from Greenville
Court House, located on what is known as the Old Harris
Settlement Road, the same being part of lot no. 28, subdivided by
B. M. Furman, Jr., Greenville, February 12, 1923, recorded
in Plat Book "G" at page 29, and is now known as lot no. 7, and
having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at the
corner of lot no. 6, running thence N. W. 120 feet with line of lot no. 6;
thence S. W. 68 feet to the corner of lot no. 8; thence 125 feet with line
of lot no. 8 to the Old Harris Settlement Road; thence with the Old
Harris Settlement Road, 68.75 feet to the beginning corner.

Also, all that other certain lot or parcel of land aforesaid, lying
and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on
the south side of Rose Avenue, and being known and designated
as lot no. 10 in Block "A" as shown on plat recorded in the C.

Beginning at iron pipe, joint corner of lots no. 16 and 15; thence with
Rose Avenue, N. 88° 20' 50" feet to iron pipe, joint corner lots no. 15 and 16; thence
with line of lot no. 14, S. 2° 20' 120 feet to iron pipe, joint corner of lots nos.
14, 15, 16 and 9; thence along joint line of lots 9 and 15, S. 88° W. 50 feet to iron
pipe, joint corner lots nos. 15, 16, 9 and 8; thence with line of lot no. 16, N.
2° W. 620 feet to the point of beginning.
