Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Summit Drive, thence corner, and running thence along the East side of Summit Drive, S. 43° 31' 110 feet along Summit Drive to a point; thence S. 43° 31' 88.3 feet along Summit Drive to an iron pin; thence S. 1-11° 21' 125 feet along Summit Drive to an iron pin; thence S. 88-49° 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 1-11° 20.00 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 88-49° E. 166.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 23° 22' 45.6 feet to the point of beginning and containing 1/2 acres, more or less.

Also All that other piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, of the East side of Summit Drive just without the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and having according to survey made by C.M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, June 21, 1929, the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Summit Drive corner of lot above described and running thence with line of said lot S. 88-49° E. 150 feet to iron pin; thence continuing with said lot, S. 1-11° 20.00 feet to iron pin; thence N. 88-49° W. 100 feet to iron pin on Summit Drive; thence with Summit Drive N. 1-11° E. 260 feet to the beginning corner containing 1/2 acre, more or less.
