all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

on the east side of Jones Avenue, near the City of Greenville having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Jones Avenue at a point 310 feet north of Burnell Street, and thence running S. 89° E. 230 feet to an iron pin in the line of lot No. 30; thence N. 5° 08' E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 89° 21' 232.7 feet to an iron pin on Jones Avenue; thence along the line of Jones Avenue S. 12° 50' feet to the beginning corner being a portion of lot No. 7 and so shown on a plat of the 2d b. P.M.C. property which plat is recorded in Plat Book 5, page 186, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and said lot being the same conveyed unto the said Isabel Chase Shouse by A. H.
