On the West side of the North Fork of Saluda River, on both sides of the old Burn Combe Road and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at the Burton Branch where it crosses the Burn Combe Road and running thence with the meanderings of said branch, S. 39° E. 13 chs. to the North Fork of Saluda River; thence up the meanderings of said river to stake corner of W. A. Hodges land; thence N. 037° 47' W. 36.40 chs. to stake 340; thence S. 30° W. 3.80 chs. to B. H.
