All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in Greenville Township, a short distance west of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the south-east corner of Lot No. 8 of the Morgan Hill Addition to Greenville, according to a plat thereof recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for said County and State in Plat Book No. Page 68, and running thence along the eastern boundary of said Lot N. 6 1/4 S. along lines of lots now or formerly belonging to Charles Olson and either Lot 123 feet to a stake on the south-east corner of a lot conveyed by Anna McCurry to H. A. Holcombe by deed recorded in said office in Book 999, Page 308, thence along line of last mentioned lot S. 76 1/2 W. 45 feet, more or less, to stake on line of lot which was sold under foreclosure proceeding as the property of Anna McCurry (see Judgment Roll no. 2472), thence along line of last mentioned lot S. 6 1/4 E.
