and to construct and maintain, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power of electricity, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to keep said right of way clear of all structures for the space of thirty-four feet (34) on each side of the center of said power line, with the further right to cut away and keep clear of said line and wires all trees or other like obstructions that might in any way endanger the proper operation of same.

of said County and State, in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of One Public Utilities Dollars, to us and paid by the SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege, and easement to go in and upon that tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of J. Freeman and Andy Smith

It is understood that this line will leave the present line which runs along the road passing the residence of Mr. & Mrs. Parney at a point about 400 feet south of present line of the Postal Telegraph Company and run eastward approximately parallel to said line of Postal Telegraph Company to the road leading from Taylor, S. C. to Brushy Creek Church, thence southward down said road until leaving the above named property. It is further understood that the Southern Public Utilities Company agrees not to destroy any crops or buildings by reason of the construction, inspection, maintenance, and operation of said line

and to construct and maintain, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power of electricity, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to keep said right of way clear of all structures for the space of thirty-four feet (34) on each side of the center of said power line, with the further right to cut away and keep clear of said line and wires all trees or other like obstructions that might in any way endanger the proper operation of same.
