Suber line; thence N. 21 W. 3.69 chains to a stone in the field; thence N. 86 E. 2.71 chains to iron pin in center of Suber Road; thence with center of said Road S. 21 E. 3.69 chains to iron pin in center of Suber Road on W.H.
