This Deed is made by John P. Stewart as trustee, under the terms of a certain deed of trust executed by L. W. Fairis to the said John P. Stewart, as trustee, under date of December 3, 1928, which deed is recorded in volume 112, page 380 of the R.M.C. for Greenville County South Carolina, and in Book J, page 145 in the office of the auditor of said County, the said Interstate Mortgage Company, grantee herein, being the assignee of the Mortgage Guaranttee Company of America, the beneficiary named in said deed, it being provided in said trust deed that the trustee named therein might deed the above described property at any time without any limitations what soever, as fully and completely as if said trustee owned the same in his own right and without obtaining any further authority from the Grantor in said trust deed than those set forth therein, and this deed being made in accordance with said power, said trustee is hereafter to be discharged from said trust and relieved of all further liability in accordance with the terms thereof.
