

Sheriff's Title To Real Estate

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:
I, C. A. Bramlett, Esquire, Sheriff of the
County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid,
send greeting.

Whereas, by virtue of an execution issued out of the County Court of Greenville, tested the 5th day of April 1929, and returnable according to law, directed to the Sheriff of Greenville County, and lodged in his office on the 5th day of April, A. D. 1929, commanding him out of the personal and real property of W. M. Johnson and Mary E. Johnson to satisfy a certain judgement which was rendered on the 5th day of April, 1929, in an action in the said Court between the Greer Bank and Trust Company, a Corporation, plaintiff, against W. M. Johnson and Mary E. Johnson, defendants, in favor of the plaintiff against the said defendants for the sum of Three Hundred and Twelve Dollars, as appears by the Judgement Roll, filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas and the County Court. I have levied upon a certain tract of land, which has been attached in the proceeding, in the County of Greenville aforesaid, hereinafter more particularly described.

And, whereas, after due and legal notice, the said tract of land was on the 6th day of May A. D. 1929, being the first Monday in said month, between the hours of eleven in the forenoon and three o'clock in the afternoon of that day, at the Court House in Greenville County, openly, publicly, and fairly, and according to the usage and custom of sales, by me sold, for and towards satisfaction of the said judgement and execution, unto the Greer Bank and Trust Company for the sum of Twenty Five Dollars, it being at that price the highest and best bid for the same.

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
