Said association to have the right of access at any and all times for the purpose of maintenance and repair of said line, and it is understood that I shall have the use of said right of way for any and all purposes not inconsistent with the use thereof for the purpose granted, to wit, the construction and maintenance of said sewer line. The said hospital shall be responsible for any damages to property and crops which may occur from said line.

I am further more to be allowed 3 connections to this line at a tap on my property which shall be provided by the Hospital.
