Received of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina One +  $\frac{100}{100}$  Dollars in consideration of which I've hereby grant unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, the right privilege and authority to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain lines of telephone and telegraph, connecting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from time to time require, upon or over and/or under the property which we own or in which we have any interest in the -

county of Greenville and State of South Carolina, bounded by the lands of Arthur J. Phillips Est. Mrs. Alice M. Glasgow et al and upon, along and/or under the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to trim from time to time any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires and cables clear at least thirty-six inches and the right to permit the attachment of and/or carry in conduit wires and cables of any other company, and with the further right to cut down and to keep cut down all trees and undergrowth within 50 feet of said line.

The Grantor for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns hereby covenants that no wire line will be erected or permitted on said property which in the judgment of the grantee, its successors and assigns will interfere with its service or endanger its lines and that no inflammable structure will be erected or permitted on said property within 50 feet of said lines. Said sum being received in full payment for the rights herein granted, said sum being full payment for all wood and timber damage of said Company agrees that land in the right-of-way shall be retained for farm purposes by the Farmers Co. liable for crop damage during construction of line.
