White, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Swift and Company, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Illinois, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Swift and Company an undivided one-half interest in and to that certain piece, parcel and lot of land and the well located thereon, fronting thirteen (13) inches on East M^{rs} Bee Avenue and running back in parallel lines S 18 3/4 W. 130 feet to a ten foot Alley and being the most westerly thirteen (13) inches of that certain tract of land situated in the city of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, described as follows, to-wit:-

All that piece, parcel and lot of land containing 5655 square feet more or less, situated lying and being in the city of Greenville, County of Greenville, State aforesaid, on the South side of East M^{rs} Bee Avenue and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron Pin 3x on said Avenue and running thence S 18 3/4 W. 130 feet to an iron Pin 3x in a ten foot Alley; thence along said Alley S 71 1/2 E. 43 1/2 feet to an iron Pin 3x; thence N. 18 3/4 E. 130 feet to an iron Pin 3x on M^{rs} Bee Avenue S. W. M^{rs} Bee corner; thence with said Avenue N. 71 1/2 W. 43 1/2 feet to the beginning corner.

To Have and To Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Swift and Company, its successors and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular,
