the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

James D. Loag, the following described real estate, to all that certain lot, piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in the Township of Hartwell and Bear Creek Township, being a part of the subdivision of L. M. Hartwell and Bear Creek, situated in the above County and State, having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake at the National Highway along said Highway Lot 23 and 24 and running thence along said Highway N. 81-45-60 feet to a stake corner of Lote 25 and 26, 148 feet and six inches to a stake corner on the line of Piedmont and Northern Railway right of way; thence N. 61-07-53 feet and two inches along said railway right of way to a stake corner Lote 23 and 24, thence S. 15-6 in line Lote 23 and 24, 159 feet and six inches to a stake at the beginning corner of this deed in front Lote 24 and 26, as shown by a plat of survey made by R.
