the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

R. L. Lindsey, the following described real estate, situated, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on Branch waters of Beardans Creek and known as a part of the L. D. McMakin place, metes and bounds as follows:  
Beginning at stake in touch on Sudduth line and running thence S 46 24 14 31 E to a stone 3x; thence N 70 12 24 23 18 E to Black Oak 3x or N; thence N 7 24 12 22 E to a stone 3x; thence N E to the corner of the R. J. Stewart land; thence S N. W. N. E. Direction with Stewart line to a stone; thence N. E. Direction by a line of chestnut trees to a stone on Dennis line; thence with Dennis line in a S. E. Direction to a stone; thence with Dennis line in a E. Direction to a stone; thence in a S. E.
