 "All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, on the South side of Paris Road, containing twenty acres, more or less, adjoining lands of J. B. Eskew, Jenkins, L. W. Paris and others and having the following metes and bounds according to plat made by R. E.
