C. M. Jones.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, the same being in the City of Greenville, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of C North Street and the Laurens Road on the west side of Richland Creek and thence thence in a southeasterly direction along the Southeast side of North Street 20 feet to the H. H. Griffis property; thence along the line of said property and the property now of former owned by W. C. Cleveland and crossing said creek 246 feet, more or less, to a point on Clough Avenue, which point is 40 feet, more or less, from the Laurens Road; thence along the West side of said Avenue in a Northwesterly direction 40 feet, more or less, to Laurens Road; thence in a straight line crossing the said creek along said Laurens Road or street to the beginning corner lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and in Ward Three of the City of Greenville and on the West side of Richland Creek, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin 3X on the left side of Richland Creek and is a corner of W. C.
