(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. H. Lancaster,  
all that certain tract or parcel of land situate  
in the County of Laurens, about four miles  
from Town of Laurens, containing 8-1/2 acres,  
bounded by lands of Arthur Robt. Givens,  
Garrett, Frank W. Neiner, John Braden and  
others.

Beginsing at a stone on line of road to Blackstone,  
thence N. 41-1/4 E. 31.80 to stone near Hickory Stump;  
thence S. 17-1/2 E. 41.43 to a stone; thence S. 66-1/2 W. 18.70  
to a line recring creek; thence up said creek  
to a stone near Road; S. 55-1/2 W. 23.40 to the beginning  
corner, being a point of what is known as the  
Phillips place as surveyed by J. A. Adams  
December 10, 1910 see plat.

It is distinctly understood and agreed between  
the parties hereto that the mortgage executed  
by the grantor hereof to J. M. and J. H. Lancaster, dated  
December 1, 1919, and recorded in the Office of Laurens  
County, in Volume 53, Page 144, shall remain in force  
and unsatisfied for the protection of the grantee

in Laurens County and jointly in Greenville  
County.
