Thomas, and his heirs and assigns, all that certain lot, piece of parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville known as designated as lot No. thirteen (13) in block "E" of what is known as the Chapin Springs Land Company property, according to a plat thereof recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyances for said County and State in Plat Book "E" at page 41, and having, according to said plat, the following notes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Heuston Street and Rose Avenue and running thence with Heuston Street N. 2° E. sixty-five (65) feet to an iron pin on the corner of lot No. twelve (12); thence with line of said lot S. 88° W. one hundred, twenty-five and two-tenths (125.2) feet to an iron pin on line of lot No. fourteen (14); thence with line of said lot S. 2° E. sixty-four and nine-tenths (64.9) feet to an iron pin on Rose Avenue thence with Rose Avenue N. 88° E. one hundred and twenty (120) feet to the beginning corner.
