(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Thomas Benson Jr., his heirs and assigns forever, All that certain piece parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, about 7 miles from Greenville, trout Native on both sides of Hooper's Creek, and having the following metes and bounds, To wit:

Beginsing at a Chestnut on Settlement road, and running thence S. 47 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 6.93 chs to a horse saddle 84 m in on a branch, thence with said branch following the meander thereof as a line to a point where said branch empties into Hooper's Creek, the courses and distances along said branch being approximately as follows, S. 81 W. 11.75 chs to bend, S. 91 W. 4.05 chs to bend, S. 12 W. 6.6 chs to a large poplar 8x10m, S. 8 W. 9.25 chs to a small poplar 87om, S. 10 E. 0 chs to Rock 3xm at confluence of said branch with Hooper's Creek, thence up said Creek approximately 8.08 E. but following the meanders of said Creek as a line approximtly 10.44 chs to rock 37m on said Creek, thence S. 75 W. 7.08 chs to a sassafras 8xm, thence S. 79 $\frac{3}{4}$  W. 7.30 chs to a stone 1m on Southeast corner of a 40 $\frac{1}{4}$  acre tract of land, thence along this tract N. 9 W. (83.00 chs) (thus line crosses Hooper's Creek) to a Red Oak 8xm thence N. 20 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 9.50 chs to stone 7m, thence N. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$  W.
