All that certain parcel or lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the East side of Brown Street, described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Brown Street 108 feet South from the corner of E. Washington Street and Brown Street intersection and running thence S. 21-05' W. 50 feet along line of lot No. 7 to an iron pin, thence N. 69-39' W. 101-7 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Brown Street, thence along said side of said street N. 21-07' E. 50 feet to the beginning corner, this being the Southern portion of lot No. 8 as shown by plot recorded in the office of P. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 109, and is the same property conveyed to Robert Wilson and me by J. T. Hunt and others by deed dated March 10, 1919, and recorded in the office of P. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 184 at page 147, and to the same property conveyed to Robert Wilson and me by May B. Foster by deed dated January 31, 1918 and recorded in the office of P. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 51 at page 154, the first of said mentioned deeds conveying an undivided two-thirds interest and the last of said deeds conveying an undivided one-third interest, and being the same property in which Robert Wilson conveyed to me his undivided one-half interest by deed dated May 16, 1927 and recorded in the office of P. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 104 at page 556.

As part of the consideration for the within conveyance the within grantee assumes and agrees to pay a mortgage in the principal sum of \$1,400.00 (\$1,400.00) executed by the within grantor H. C. Frank H. Cagle on September 26, 1927 said mortgage being of record in the office of P. M. C. for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 191 at page 102.

Further it is understood that the within conveyance is made subject to a one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00) mortgage executed by G. Ed. Cundtts &amp; Robert Wilson on September 10, 1927 said mortgage being of record in the office of P. M. C. for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 191 at page 292 it being the distinct understanding of the parties that the within grantee does not assume payment of the last mentioned mortgage.
