all that piece of land or tract of land in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, on the Harris Bridge Road, containing 18 1/2 acres more or less, being the following corner and bounds to wit:
Beginning at a stake in Harris Bridge Road, thence S 59 1/2 E 343 to bend, thence N 57 1/2 E 10.22 to stake in said road, thence N 51 E 17.25 to C. P., thence N 29 1/2 W 10.40 to C. O., thence N 39 1/2 E 12.60 to the beginning corner.
Being part of the square tract of land reserved to John H. Jones by the executors of the estate of Oliver H. Jones by the deed dated 1921 and recorded Sept 31 1921 in Vol. 73, page 250, bounded on the east by the property of W. H. Murphy, on the south by D. C. Cunningham, on the west by C. H.
