I have three acres, parcels, or lots of land in Greenville
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near
the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville and being a
portion of the sub-division known as "Overbrook"
Beginning at a stake on Partansburg Road, joint corner
of lots No. 35 and 36, running thence in a southwesterly
direction with said road 80 feet to a stake, joint corner
of lots No. 34 and 35; thence with joint lines of said lots
in an easterly direction 167.2 feet to an iron gin on a
tire foot alley; thence in a northerly direction on line
of said alley 64 feet to an iron gin, joint corner of
lots No. 35 and 36; thence with said joint lines in
a westerly direction 160.4 feet to a stake at the beginning
corner, and being known as lot No. 35 according to
