All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying  
and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina  
in Belvoir Springs Township, at the intersection of  
Pine Avenue and the Gold Rutherford Road (Mountain Creek  
Road) and near the Paris School Property, and having the  
following distances to - west: Beginninging at the Northwest  
intersection of said Rutherford Road and Pine Avenue  
and running thence with said Rutherford Road in  
a Northern direction, 210 feet to a pine, thence in a western  
direction in a pine parallel with Pine Avenue, 210  
feet to a pine, thence in a southerly direction in a line  
parallel with Rutherford Road, 210 feet to a pine on Pine  
Avenue; thence with Pine Avenue, in an Easterly direction
