tract of land over which the Electric transmission
line is to be constructed in said County and
State bounded by lands of J. B. Wason, Stewart
Gowder, P. H. James, J. W. Watson, W. D. Ridgeway and
Mrs. Eliftoe

and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.

It is further agreed and understood, that this Electric transmission line, referred to above, (wires, poles, and other necessary apparatus and appliances) are to be used exclusively for the transmission of Electric light and power, and shall be constructed on the east side of the newly therewith public road, and the poles set within eight (8) feet of the center of the present road side ditch.
