All our right title and interest in and to All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being situate in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville in the City of Greenville, in Ward Two of said City, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake in the East line of Pettigrue Street, corner of lot No. 1, runs North 64 degrees 55 minutes East with the East line of Pettigrue Street 60 feet to a corner of lot No. 3, thence with the line of lot No. 3, S. 20.35 E. 138.4 feet to stake in the West line of a ten foot alley; thence with the the West line of the ten foot alley S. 64.56 W. 60 feet to a corner of lot No. 1; thence with a line of lot No. 1, N. 20.35 W. 138.4 feet to the beginning corner, being known and designated as lot No. 2, on the plat of the property of Thomas F. Parker, Surveyed, Feb. 1916, and revised April 1919 by R. E. Dalton and recorded in R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "E" page 115. It being the same lot conveyed by Harriet H. McCallister to Ida C.
