(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*Paul Davidson, his heirs and assigns forever;*

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, described as follows:

Beginning at corner of Lot #64 and running N. 51-30 W. 111.8 feet; thence S. 47-25 W. 127 feet to Boyce Spring Avenue; thence along said Boyce Spring Avenue N. 84-36 E. 115 feet; thence along said Boyce Spring Avenue N. 85-54 E. 68 feet to the beginning point being Lot no 65, and a triangular shaped lot, of the property of J. G. B. Lee, Trustee for the heirs of W. B. Harrison, made by Dalton & Nevers.

This deed is executed in order that the intention of the parties may be more definitely expressed as appears in a conveyance heretofore made by the grantor to the grantee on the 22nd day of March 1934 as recorded in the R.
