Willie H. Bynum her heirs and assigns

All that certain tract of land situate on the west side of the White Horse road, County and State aforesaid, and being known and designated as tract No. 1 in the partition of the W. M. Bynum estate, as shown by a sub division and plat thereof made by W. A. Foster, surveyor, May 28, 1930, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and dimensions as shown by said plat, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin N. M. in the center of the White Horse Road, at the northeast corner of tract No. 2 in said sub division, and running thence along the center of said road, N. 5 1/2 W. 3 55 to an iron pin 10 M. in the center of said road, thence S. 86 1/2 W. 14.75 to stone 0 M. thence S. 49 1/2 E. 13.20 to an iron pin N. M. and in line of tract No. 2, thence along line of tract No. 2 N. 76.8 96.00 to the beginning corner aforesaid, containing 11 acres more or less.

This is the same tract of land deeded to me by E. Bynum, Master, June 21, 1930, the deed being recorded in Vol. 130 at page 439.
