(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

G. E. Crenshaw his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land  
in Greenville Township, Greenville County,  
State of South Carolina, in the Town of  
West Greenville on the electric car line and  
near Pendleton Road, and on what is known  
as Woodside Avenue, and having the follow-  
ing metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on Woodside  
Avenue, corner of property formerly owned  
by W. A. Bates, and running thence with  
Woodside Avenue No. 1744 S. 10.65 feet to  
pipe, thence S. 73-45 E. 46 feet to pin on Bates  
line, thence with his line N. 86-23 E. 47.45  
feet to the beginning.

It is understood and agreed that the  
grantee herein, his heirs and assigns shall  
forever have the right to use the wall of the  
wooden building which is on the line of  
the above described property, and that the  
grantee, his heirs and assigns shall have the  
right to extend said wall to such height as  
he may see fit, and also a strip of land  
six (6) inches in width and one-half interest  
in brick wall on west side of the above de-  
scribed land running through from Woodside  
Avenue northwesterly a distance of fifty feet.
