(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*Adeline G. Garrison her heirs and assigns;*  
All of our undivided right, title and interest of, in and to all that tract of land being a part of the old horse place containing 59.28 acres, more or less, and is tract No. 3 of the survey of W. J. Riddle. Beginning at an iron pin in the Standing Springs Road and runs thence N. 50 W. along J. K. Baldwin's line 21.80 to a maple; thence still along his line N. 52 W. 8.50 to a stake in Creek; thence down the meanders of said of said Creek as a line to a stake at mouth of a branch, thence continuing down the meanders of said Creek as a line passing the mouth of another branch to a stake which is one of the corners of tract No. 4; thence S. 81.30 E. 22.50 to an iron pin in said Standing Springs Road; thence N. 3 E. 6.06 to a stake in said road; thence further along said road N. 14.30 E. 7.63 to an iron pin in the beginning corner.
