W. Hampton Smith, and his Heirs and Assigns, forever:
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
lying and being in Grove Township, State and County
aforesaid, containing forty-three one hundredths (43/100)
or one acre, more or less, having the following metes
and bounds:

Beginning at a corner (W. Hampton Smith's corner) thence
along with the line of the said W. Hampton Smith E. 3. 60^{ft}
(chain) to a corner, thence N. 45° E. 1. 63 along with the line
of the P. T. Railroad Co. to a corner, thence N. 88^{1/4} W. 3. 63
joining with the line of U. A. Johnson to the center of the State
Highway, thence S. 45° W. 1. 77 along the center of the said State
Highway to the beginning corner. The aforesaid metes and
