The failure of said Seller to exercise the option, aforesaid, at any time of any default, shall not operate to bar or abridge his right to exercise such option upon any subsequent default or the Buyer. It is agreed that a letter mailed to the Buyer at Markley Street, Greenville, S.C., shall be sufficient notice of the exercise of such option by the Seller.

- 4. It is further agreed that said Buyer shall have the right to pay the balance of the said installment at any time before maturity.
- 5. The Buyer agrees to pay all taxes and special assessments upon said property during the life of this contract.
 - 6. That time is of the essence of this contract.
