Bannister by William D. Mayfield and W. M. Bannister, Executors of the last will and testament of the said John Bannister, deceased, by a deed bearing date January 4th, 1893, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for the said State and County, on September 18th, 1893, in Book "AAA", at page 121. From this tract No.1 which contained 257 acres, Hannah F. Bannister conveyed a portion, containing 1272 acres, to S. L. McBee by deed hereinabove referred to. This being the same tract of land conveyed to Alvin H. Dean, Deceased, by J. R. Jenkinson, as shown by deed dated September 17, 1909, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 4, page 689.

To have and to hold, all and singular, the said premises unto the said James M. Dean, his heirs and assigns forever.

And we do hereby hind ourselves, our successors, the heirs of Alvin fi. Dean, Deceased, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Tamer M. Dean, his heirs and assigns, against us, our successors, the heirs of Alvin H. Dean, Deceased, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

This deed is executed in accordance with the Agreement made between Sarah P. Dean James M. Bean, Kate A. Hoy, and Annie Belle Dean, heirs of Alvin H. Deen, Deceased, on the 1st day of October 1930, which is recorded in Deed Book, Volume 158, at Page 299.
