provisions of this paragraph, the one so violating the same shall be responsible for the payment of such additional rates of insurance as may be incurred bysaid breach.

- 8. The Lessees accept the premises covered by this Lease in its present condition, and agree that they are to be responsible for all operating and running expenses incident to their occupancy thereof, and that the Lessor shall bear no expense whatseever in connection therewith, except, that the Lessor will maintain in reasonable repair the roof of said building. The Lessees agree to keep said premises in good order and will promptly replace and repair all breakages, defacements and damages thereto; that upon the termination of this lease, or prior surrender of said premises for default as herein specified, the Lessees will vacate and surrender said premises to said Lessor in as good condition as they now are or shall hereafter be placed in, ordinary wear and tear and damage by the elements excepted.
- 9. The Lessees further agree that they will not assign or transfer this lease nor sublet any part of said premises without the written consent of the Lessor.
