Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

Whereas,

*O. Snaman**Kate Bushman*

on or about the 13th day of January in the year of
 our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-three exhibited Rev complaint in the
 Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Annie J. Campbell, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 19th
 day of January 1933, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
 adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by O. Snaman.

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Kate Bushman for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-34-98)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, O. Snaman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Kate Bushman,

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the North side of Lorraine Drive, just west of McDowell Avenue, being part within and partly without the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, S. C., and being known and designated as Lot No. 33 in a plat of the property of the J. L. Jackson Estate, Plat of same being recorded in Plat Book H, Page 207, R. M. Office for Greenville County, and reference is hereby made to said Plat for a more particular description of said lot.

No dwelling is to be erected on the above described lot nearer than 20 feet to Lorraine Drive, not to cost less than \$3,000.00. Said lot is not to be sold, leased or rented to persons of African descent. The foregoing building restrictions are to be enforced for a period of ten years from November 17, 1932. The above lot is the same conveyed to Mary E. and Brody Jenkinson by Charles M. Jenkinson, et al., by deed dated November 17, 1932, and recorded in Deed Book 168, Page 96, R. M. Office for Greenville County."

The consideration by this deed is exchange of lots pursuant to a Decree of Court and the lot herein conveyed is valued at \$1000.00.
